A minty red wine with bold fruit flavour at the heart of it, complemented by a general softness. If you're in the mood for a hearty red, this is an easy wine to like. Blackberry, leather, hay and cedarwood characters sweep confidently through the palate, before chewy tannin steps in to help shape the finish.
