“A fine vintage in the Heathcote region with low yields on offer from the vineyards used for this wine. Chocolate, black fruits, mocha, coffee grinds and soy swirl around the nose. A wine which has focus, is seamless and offers medium to good length. This is an eight to twelve year proposition and there is room for further improvement over that period.”

“Sweet ripe plum and blackberry make way for black olive, gumleaf, mocha and leather. The palate is full bodied, with immediate chewy oak tannins, black fruits at the fore and the additions of dark chocolate and ground coffee. The tannins are grainy and stacked, pulling the palate into line to a mocha infused finish. It works.”

“A bright and youthful red. Complex aromas of mulberry, blackberry, ironstone, bramble, dried herbs and spice. Firm, structured and youthful.
