VINTAGE CONDITIONS

The climate is hot with high evaporation rates and generally low rainfall, making irrigation essential. The climate is also continental, resulting in long sunny days and noticeably cooler nights. Modern viticultural and winemaking techniques mean that the climate can be seen as one of the region's strengths. Long sunshine hours ensure fruit ripens fully and low relative humidity results in little incidence of disease.

WINEMAKING

The fruit was machine harvested and selected from vineyards in the Murray Darling and Riverland regions. Conditions for vintage were ideal, yields were good and the fruit was in excellent condition.

TASTING NOTES

This wine displays aromatics of dark red fruits, blackberries and cherries with hints of cedar and spice. The palate highlights well balanced wine with upfront fruits and well integrated toasty tannins.
