Dry with ripe fruit flavours touch the palate first, moderate tannins and acidity add texture and mouthfeel. A balanced even tempered wine with core dark berry and roasted plum flavours, clove and toasty wood qualities. Well made with moderate length, best drinking from 2023 through 2028.
