generally low rainfall, making irrigation essential. Long sunshine hours ensure fruit ripens fully and low relative humidity results in little. The fruit was machine harvested and selected from vineyards in South Eastern Australia. Conditions for vintage were ideal,

yields were good and the fruit was in excellent

condition.
