Produced in the French region of Cognac, G'Vine is a hint as to what this unique gin contains. It's actually infused with Ugni Blanc grape, as well as some more standard botanicals including ginger root, liquorice, cardamom, cassia bark, coriander, cubeb berries, nutmeg, lime and even a bit of juniper.

This French gin is made in the Cognac region and has been around since 2001. It is a distinctive drop, with a mysterious scent akin to that sweet banana smell you get from crushed manuka leaves. This is actually derived from the vine flower of the Ugni Blanc grape variety, which is picked and macerated in a grape spirit (also unusual, as most gins are made using grain spirit). Juniper takes a back seat to the floral characters, while the use of the grape spirit gives this gin an attractive, fleshy texture.

On the nose there's a clean, crisp scent with a slight sweetness lingering with ginger making an easy appearance as it enters your palate. A fresh floral hit to begin with but mellows out rather quickly with the flavours of juniper and ginger leaving a lasting, slightly dry finish.
