Bright, even, pale-salmon. Moderately fine, persistent bubbles. The nose is vibrant, softly filled the glass with aromas of raspberries, red cherries and dried cranberries, underlying pastry and toasty elements. Medium-full bodied, aromas of red cherries, raspberries interweave stonefruit, unfolding dried cranberries, custard and pastry. The mouthfeel is creamy, elevated by the soft mousse; the fruit is vibrant, supported by a lacy acid line. The wine is youthful and bright with great balance of fruit and vibrancy, yeasty-autolysis added interest, showing positive complexity. Serve as an aperitif or match with cured salmon over the next 2-3 years.

Cremant d'Alsace is a perennially underrated sparkling wine, and Gustave Lorentz's rose bottling is a clear indicator of why you should be drinking more of it. Creamier than Prosecco and drier than Cava, it's a very fruit-forward wine that's almost overwhelming with notes of strawberry and raspberry. Some cinnamon-driven notes give it a certain spiciness, while the finish, lightly sweet with a lychee character on the very end. The fruit is fab, but it's that creaminess that makes Cremant always more fun than perhaps it ought to be.
