The 2016 Puligny villages from Maison Drouhin is lovely, offering up a very classic aromatic profile of pear, white peach, chalky soil tones, a touch of butter, vanillin oak and a lovely floral topnote. On the palate the wine is deep, full-bodied and nicely complex, with a plump core of very pure fruit, fine soil signature, bright, zesty acids and fine length and grip on the exuberant finish. This is going to drink beautifully from the moment that it is released. 2018-2030.
