

BAIN'S CAPE MOUNTAIN WHISKY

SOUTH AFRICA'S FIRST SINGLE GRAIN WHISKY

HISTORY

Inspired by the Cape Mountains and its natural beauty, Bain's Cape Mountain Whisky is South Africa's first single grain whisky and pays tribute to Andrew Geddes Bain, a Scotsman who built the Bainskloof Pass connecting the town of Wellington to the interior in 1853. The whisky is crafted at the James Sedgwick Distillery situated in one of South Africa's most picturesque regions near the Bainskloof Pass where the area's magnificent peaks, cool, sparkling streams, wooded valleys and wealth of indigenous fynbos give rise to the creation of the naturally pure Bain's Cape Mountain Whisky.

CRAFTING AND MATURATION

Only the finest South African grain is used together with water that flows over 850 million year old sandstone and indigenous fynbos, setting Bain's Cape Mountain Whisky apart from any other whisky produced in the world. The whisky is distilled in column stills and quite uniquely double-matured – first for three years in casks previously used for bourbon, before being revatted into a fresh set of bourbon casks for a further maturation period that result in its exceptionally smooth and unique taste.

TASTING NOTES

- Colour:** Warm, inviting, golden amber
Nose: Delicious combination of floral, banana, honey, toasted hazelnuts and toffee aromas. By adding a splash of water the whisky opens up to include wood, vanilla and spice aromas.
Taste: Beautifully balanced vanilla, cocoa butter and light spices from the oak casks.
Finish: Exceptionally smooth with a long, warm mouthfeel filled with coconut cream and all spice.
