

Ledaig 10yo

Ledaig is the heavily peated whisky produced at Tobermory distillery. Ledaig is produced for 6 months of the year with Tobermory being produced for the other 6. The malted barley used to produce Ledaig has a phenolic level of ~40ppm.

Appearance: Bright lemony gold.

Nose: Sweet briny smokiness with a distinctly island character that hints at mild antiseptic, creosote, mint chocolate and floral seaside aromas.

Palate: Sweet with medicinal flavours, spicy pepper with peaty smoke and vanilla. A spicy white pepper finish with hints of liquorice, cloves, and a slight saltiness.

Unchill-filtered at 46.3%, natural colour
