Moderately rich and fleshy Prosecco with a pleasingly smooth texture. An initial hint of sweetness is balanced by drying acidity. Quite a gutsy style, with subtle savoury and fruit flavours.

A lively sparkling with a lovely appealing bouquet that shows white peach, apple and floral characters. The palate is refreshing and vibrant with good intensity and a lingering crisp finish. It's dry but very smooth and fruity at the same time. A lovely drink.

Very pale straw colour with green hues, this has a fine bead with good persistence. Elegant on bouquet with light, attractive, citrus fruit, floral and green apple aromas. Dryish to taste, this is clean and light with soft frothy effervescence and textures, and gently sweet flavours of white stonefruits and honeysuckle. The acidity is soft and the palate line is carried stylishly to a moderately sustained finish. This is a clean, soft and delightfully soft Prosecco to drink as an aperitif over the next 2 years. 100% Prosecco grapes from the northern Piave district in Treviso, Veneto, Martinotti-Charmat method sparkling, fermented to 11.0% alc.
