Dark amber lifted toffee, sea salt. Round, smooth and broad with hints of figs, dried fruit, walnut and orange peel. Long finish.

Precise, textbook Oloroso, giving aromas of nuts, old wood, caramel, smoked meats, vanilla and caramel. The palate is long and harmonious, with a silky texture, Christmas spices and a saline finish.

Leans to the generous side, with a slightly off-dry mix of sesame, buckwheat and date flavors,
