Smokehead Sherry Bomb is a peaty Islay single malt that has well and truly earned its name. Blasted by rich, sweet and spicy Spanish sherry casks, it has emerged as fiery, explosive, heavy hitting dram that has even turned our skull red.

Sherry and peat go toe to toe with Smokehead Sherry Bomb. It's a well-peated single malt from an undisclosed Islay distillery, matured in Oloroso sherry casks, boasting smoke and dried fruit by the truckload. It's a powerfully flavoursome dram, and unashamedly so.

It might well be the exact, highly unusual taste you've been waiting for. It might be a cannonball careering towards you that you're keen to avoid. Either way, we've taken our 'not for everyone' mantra to a whole new level.

#### THE FIRST IMPRESSION

Thick peat lets you know you've got a serious Islay single malt on your hands. Then a fruitier, creamier feel – soft rich oak, soothing custard and vanilla. But don't get comfortable – this is only the beginning.

#### THE FULL-ON FLAVOUR

Tie yourself down and wait for the hit of oily black smoke, with a rich, heavy mouthcoating peaty feel. Then along comes a sweet sticky flavour of barbecued banana (yes, really), tangy sultanas and dried fruits. Told you it was different.

#### THE FINALE

The peat returns, just as you hoped/feared it would. This time it's brought some authentic Spanish sherry oakiness with it, pleasingly and disturbingly sweet. And one last sharp salty reminder that you're not dealing with the ordinary here.



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
