September 2022 *A classic Marlborough riesling in a medium-dry style with lime cordial, grapefruit, white rose and oyster shell flavours. Single-vineyard wine from the coastal Blind River sub-region. Nice sweet/sour tension.*

October 2022 *A bit reductive on the nose but with some air you are greeted with aromas of white tea, preserved lemon peel, lime and white peaches. Mediumbodied with succulent fruit and citrus acidity. The palate gains a bit of savory complexity as it develops and ends with green apple and sliced lemon. Sustainable. Drink now. Screw cap.*

October 2022 *A very elegant bouquet with soft white flowers then apple, a deep core of minerality and citrus fruits. Off-dry on the palate with a satin texture and gentle sweetness, contrasting acidity, core fruit flavours reflect the bouquet led by apple then citrus and finishing with mineral and flowers. Balanced, well made and ready to drink from 2022 through 2030.*

January 2023 *The 2022 Riesling Anandale Farm is Blank Canvas' 1st varietal bottling from the vineyard, a cool, exposed site giving huge acidity. It's a delightfully perfumed, delicate kabinett-style Riesling (27g/L) with 9% alcohol. Homemade lemonade meets green apple jesh and a joral blossom twist. The acidity leaves a refreshing jnish that's clean and vibrant but never austere. There's lots of pleasure here, even in youth, but it has the substance to age gracefully.*
