



## 2022 CARRICK JOSEPHINE RIESLING

Arthur's Vineyard, Carrick, Bannockburn, SWNZ BIOGRO-5056

Josephine is the alternative name given by sailors to the Carrick Bend knot. Josephine, our reserve Riesling, is made from selected parcels of grapes hand-harvested from Arthur's Vineyard. The sweetest wine of the range, it is a medium-sweet, mosel-esque style.

Winemaking: Hand-picked, whole-bunch pressed, then fermented using native yeast in tank. The fermentation is brought to a close when an appropriate balance of sugar and acid is found.

Additions: Bentonite Clay (Fining), Potassium Metabisulphite (Preservative, anti-oxidant), Yeast Hull Supplement  
Filtration and/or Fining: Sterile

"The 2022 Josephine was derived from a low-yielding vintage which delivered impeccable fruit, both in terms of bunch structure, but also flavour intensity. The resulting wine exudes fruit intensity both on the nose and on the palate, apricot, lime, orange peel and passionfruit notes can be found. It's zesty, well-balanced, and generous, with a long finish reminiscent of orange sherbet."
