**TASTING NOTES**

2020 Pinot Gris shows red apple and ripe fruit characters on the nose. The palate has spicy undertones with clean tropical fruit balance. The wine has wonderful depth and complexity along with an off dry finish. This is a complex Pinot Gris that will age well over the next 5 years.

**VINTAGE CONDITIONS**

The 2020 growing season was one to remember for the amazing weather conditions in Marlborough. During Summer and Autumn we had warm and dry conditions throughout, allowing for clean fruit and an early start to the vintage. These conditions resulted in grapes that were picked with good natural acidity relative to their sugar and flavour ripeness. 2020 will prove to be an exceptional vintage.

**VINIFICATION**

The fruit for this wine was sourced from the Rapaura sub-region of Marlborough. The grapes were harvested at different maturity levels in order to add complexity to the finished wine. The pressed juice was fermented in stainless steel and old French oak barrels before being blended back together for a brief period of lees aging. Oxidative juice handling techniques were employed to minimise phenolic uptake.
