Harvest:

The grapes are predominantly from Marlborough's Southern Valleys. 2022 was a dry hot Summer in Marlborough. The weather conditions allowed the vines to ripen with no pressure of disease, maintaining intense and delicious flavours. The grapes were machine harvested.

Craft:

The grapes were crushed with open rollers and soaked with skins for 7-10 days (pre and post yeast inoculation). We used a mix of tank and barrel maturation to influence structure, fruit forward characters and harmonious notes of spicy french oak.

Colour:

Dark garnet with a hint of purple at the edges.

Aroma:

Bright, lively red and dark berry fruit, couple with an earthy bouquet.

Taste:

A juicy wine, with delicious plum, strawberry, black cherry flavours, a hint of spice and fine tannins.
