Pink 2022

Spiritually, the mandala pattern is said to help transform ordinary minds into enlightened ones, while the shape symbolises balance and perfection. Pink represents compassion and glamour while silver is said to restore balance.

Tasting Notes

Our 2022 Pink has a delicate pink hue. The nose has nuances of ripe watermelon, strawberries and raspberry while the palate is moreish, dry and full of flavour with a gentle balance of acidity.

Vineyards and viticulture

Made predominantly from Pinot Noir grown at our Chaytors Road vineyard, the gravel soils and coastal influence produce grapes with ripe, bright and fruity characters ideal for this wine.

Winemaking

The Pinot Noir was picked especially for this wine at low brix and with crisp acidity. The grapes were pressed and the skins removed immediately to achieve the lovely, pale pink colour. The juice was fermented in stainless steel tanks at cool temperatures with a specially selected, cultured yeast from Provence in the south of France.
