Bel Canto means 'Beautiful Singing'. Based on the estate's mature vines at Waipara, in North Canterbury, the 2024 vintage was hand-picked at an advanced level of ripeness and tankfermented. Bright, light lemon/green, it is an invitingly scented wine with a powerful presence. Mouthfilling, it has rich yet delicate, very energetic flavours of peaches, lemons and lychees, and a very long, slightly off-dry finish. Already highly approachable, it's full of personality and likely to be longlived.

Bright, even, pale yellow gold. The nose is full, with aromas of stonefruit, lychee, underlying citrus, zest, jasmine and orange blossom. Fullbodied, dry to taste, aromas of apricot, lychee and grapefruit intertwined with grapefruit peels, jasmine and orange blossom. The fruit is lush and shows good weight; invigorating acidity carries zesty spice and floral fragrance to an extended, layered finish. A consistent, complex and intriguing Riesling.

This 2024 Riesling has a shining straw yellow colour with a soft lime glow. On the inviting nose you have honeysuckle, grilled pineapple, quince and a subtle hint of Turkish delight. The light to medium palate is engaging while celebrating those vibrant honeysuckle, floral and citrus flavours and a deft splash of pineapple, and all delivered to your tastebuds on soft acidity. The wine has personality and a suave nature from a gentle level of residual fruit sweetness giving this wine a beguiling grace and balance, while aways leading to a refreshing off-dry finish.

Bel Canto is the evocative name of the pinnacle of Pegasus Bay Rieslings - a dry, full bodied, intensely aromatic and vibrantly refreshing wine. The grapes in this wine typically spent significantly longer on the vine to allow them to develop the broad array of grapey aromatic complexity, which brings candied mandarin, a note of honey and subtle white peachy notes, along with bold citrus zest to balance the finish, which is crisp in style with lingering flavours.
