Full, deep purple with a black core, lighter on the rim. The nose is gently full, with aromas of black cherry, blackberry intermixed smoke, mint bush, animal, cedar and spice. Medium-bodied, black cherry and blackberry aromas are underlined by a savoury edge, unfolding nutmeg, cedar, menthol and a hint of smoke. The mouthfeel is creamy with a soft, ripe tannin grip; integrated acidity carries spice and savoury details to a comforting, smooth finish. This blackfruited red blend possesses a smooth and creamy mouthfeel with a ripe tannin structure and savoury reveals.

This powerful, very inviting red is an unusual blend of pinot noir (85%) and cabernet sauvignon (15%) from the 2021 vintage (it was made to display 'classic pinosity' with 'added depth, vigour and a touch of brawn'). Already drinking well, it is deeply coloured, mouthfilling, sweetfruited and supple, with cherry, plum and spice flavours, gentle acidity and a long, harmonious finish.

October 2022 Made predominantly with Pinot Noir fruits and small amount of Cabernet Sauvignon, aged in French barrel for 12 months this wine showcases aromas of black currant and plem then dark cherry and a touch of black berry. The barrel ageing adds complexity and spice. Fruity, textured, fresh and quite delicious on the palate with flab=vours that mirror the bouquet. Medium+ acidity with plenty of fine tannins add texture and mouthfeel. Ballanced, well made and ready to drink from 2022 through 2026.
