The 2022 Estate Vineyards Sauvignon Blanc has been fully tank fermented, no solids but it was left on the lees postfermented for texture. There are notes of cheesecloth, pineapple lumps. Pink Lady apples and saline acidity. Its fleshy, with preserved citrus, juicy acidity and plenty of brine, then sugar snap peas, Nashi pears and a hint of guava/lychee. The fruit was sourced totally from the estate vineyards in Hawkes Bay; Havelock Hills, Gimblett Gravels and Dartmoor.
